

# How to pair Aranet devices to my smartphone using the Aranet Home app

Download the Aranet Home app and connect your smartphone to Aranet devices via Bluetooth\* to:

- Access real-time measurement data.
- Store up to a 90-day measurement history and export it as a CSV file.
- Track CO2 levels, temperature, humidity or atmospheric pressure data.
- Change sensor measurement interval.
- Access all nearby Aranet devices.
- Activate firmware updates for Aranet devices
- Enable connections to the Homey smart home system.
- Display Aranet measurements on larger TV screens.



Aranet Home App is currently available on iOS and Android devices. Requires Android 6.0 or newer or iOS 11.00 or newer.

\* Access to the device's location should be allowed because of the general requirement for Bluetooth apps to work correctly on Android OS.

To connect Aranet devices, make sure Bluetooth connectivity is enabled on both your mobile device and your Aranet monitor.

Then, follow these steps:

- 1 Launch the Aranet Home app
- 2 Add Aranet devices to the app by pressing + PAIR NEW DEVICE.
- 3 Select the desired Aranet device from the devices list and press + PAIR.
- 4 Accept the pairing procedure.
- 5 Enter the 6-digit pin code that is shown on the display of your Aranet device

We advise you to check the app for Aranet's newest firmware versions regularly and use the offered upgrades
